Dear Parent/Guardian:

On February 27, our juniors will take the ACT, which is being provided free of charge by the state of Ohio. The ACT serves as a college-entrance exam, and it is also one of the testing pathways to graduation in Ohio. Even if your child is not planning to attend college, if he/she earns college-ready scores on the ACT, he/she does not need to meet the 18 points required for the End-of-Course exams. For both of these reasons, it is important for your child to prepare for the test.

On February 12, we are going to offer our juniors a preparation class for the ACT, which will be taught by Bob Brausch, who runs Tutoring by B2, and teaches the "Attacking the ACT" workshop. Mr. Brausch usually charges \$60 for his ACT-prep seminar; however, we are excited to offer our students the seminar for the cost of only \$10. The \$10 charge covers the workshop, transportation to/from Bible-Baptist Church, and pizza/drinks for lunch.

If your child is going to attend this educational field trip, please return this permission slip and \$10 (checks should be made out to Clinton-Massie High School) to Ms. Beres or Mrs. Potts in the counseling office. There will be no charge for students who are on free/reduced lunch, but they will still need to return the permission slip. Please submit the permission slip and \$10 at the same time. The last day to submit a permission slip is Wednesday, February 7.

The workshop will run from 9-2 on February 12. We will take busses from CMHS to Bible Baptist Church, where the workshop will be held. Students will need to bring a pencil and a calculator. Students who are full time off-campus CCP and students who attend the vocational schools may drive themselves to Bible Baptist Church. All other students will be riding the bus from CMHS to the church and back.
