

## Welcome to ALEKS Math Assessment *and Prep and Learning Modules* Sinclair Community College

ALEKS is a web-based assessment that uses artificial intelligence to map a student's readiness for college math courses. The assessment is up to 30 questions and generally takes 60-90 minutes to complete. Keep in mind that a "Placement Assessment" is not a test, but is designed to determine what you know and what you are prepared to learn. Now that you have completed the ALEKS assessment you should have a much better sense of your math readiness—and you have the opportunity to brush up on your skills and take the placement test again should you need to do so.

### IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ALEKS!

- Various Sinclair programs have different math requirements, therefore you will want to meet with your Academic Advisor to review your placement results and determine how they relate to your specific need or program requirement.
- This ONE assessment includes FIVE proctored attempts – with no cost for each attempt.
- You must complete **five hours** of Prep and Learning Modules before each attempt is unlocked.
- ALEKS is web based, so you can easily access your Prep and Learning from home, school, the library, etc.
- Assistance is available in the Academic Resource Center (ARC) at the Downtown Dayton Campus.
- You have one year from your first attempt to use your remaining attempts—and six months access to the Prep and Learning Modules.

### HOW TO LOGIN TO PREP AND LEARNING MODULES

1. Go to [aleks.sinclair.edu](http://aleks.sinclair.edu)
2. Click the “CLICK HERE” Red Button
3. Login using your username (firstname.lastname) and password that you reset when you tested
4. Click the class under active classes and it should take you to the Prep and Learning Modules
