January

- **Priority Deadline for Applications**
- Completed applications that are received by this date will be processed in the first round of acceptances—this is especially important with programs that fill quickly.
- Applications are considered on a space-available basis through the second week of the new school year.

March 1

- **Initial Status (Acceptance) Notifications Sent**
- Applications will continue to be processed as they are submitted and notifications sent throughout the enrollment period.
- Follow up meeting with Career Specialist at their High School in April.

May 16

- **Prepare for Laurel Oaks Day**
- Students accepted to Laurel Oaks are invited to spend the day on campus to meet their classmates and Laurel Oaks staff.
- Invitations are mailed home with emergency medical forms that must be returned for a student to participate.
