The Clinton-Massie Business Scholarship Fund - Application

The Clinton-Massie Business Scholarship will be awarded to graduating students of Clinton-Massie High School pursuing a degree in a business related field of study. The scholarships are possible as a result of the generosity of an anonymous donor. They may be renewable for 4 years if the requirements for maintaining eligibility, discussed below, are fulfilled.

- A. Complete all materials within this application and return to guidance counselor no later than the **April 15th** each year.
- B. Those applying for the scholarship must demonstrate all of the following:
 - adequacy for an institution of higher learning (3.0 for HS class work)
 - good character and citizenship (letter of reference from teacher)
 - seriousness of purpose (1 page essay as to why you are a good candidate)
 - appreciable need for financial assistance (complete confidential financial statement)
- C. The scholarships shall be for study towards a bachelor's degree in business related areas of study. A business-related field of study may include, but is not limited to, degrees in: business, finance, marketing, agricultural business, educational administration, etc. The Foundation Board will make the final determination about whether or not a particular course of study qualifies as business-related.
- D. The student must be enrolled (full time) in either a 2 year or 4-year college and working towards a bachelor's degree in a business related field of study. A statement from the college's counseling department or student's advisor confirming that the student is continuing in a business-related field may be necessary.
- E. The recipients shall maintain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for college level work.
- F. The recipient shall file an official copy of college grades and documentation of the student's field of study with the Clinton County Foundation by August 1st of each year to determine continuing eligibility and to ensure timely payments to the colleges.
