## Farmer's Union Scholarship Award

#### Qualifications

- 1. Applicant must be a Clinton County High School senior, graduating in the current school year, who will be attending a College, University, an accredited Trade or Technical School. Applicant must be interested in pursuing Agricultural related courses. The applicant may also be a college student, pursuing Agricultural related courses, who is a resident of Clinton County, Ohio.
- 2. Applicant must be pursuing an Associate or Bachelor's Degree or equivalent Vocational degree at an accredited Trade or Technical School.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Eligibility is based on scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, volunteer activities in the community and a personal essay. No student will be considered if he or she has exhibited bad behavior, poor citizenship or has been in trouble with law enforcement.
- 5. A scholarships will be awarded and paid to each recipient upon proof that they have been accepted by the school of their choice and that they are attending said school.

#### Procedures

- Print in ink or type answers on attached SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION. If more space is needed than provided, please attach additional sheets of paper to the application. Complete all questions, including one of the ESSAY QUESTIONS, as instructed on the application.
- Complete the Application and Essay along with the ACADEMIC REPORT from your high school academic advisor or guidance counselor and have them mail your completed information to:

- 3. Application, Essay and Academic Report must be mailed and postmarked by May 1 of the current school year or it will not be accepted.
- 4. The Scholarships will be awarded according to the qualifications listed above and will be based equally on academic achievement, clearly stated goals and objectives, school and community leadership accomplishments and thoroughness in completion of the Essay question.
- 5. The selection process will be handled by the Clinton County Farmer's Union Scholarship Committee. Applications will be submitted to the committee anonymously.
- 6. The Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced after the seventh day of May of the current school year. The Scholarship will be forfeited, if the recipient does not attend a school of higher learning.
